An Invitation from Professor K.M. Chan

A satellite meeting of the **International Symposium of Tendons & Ligaments (ISL&T)** will be held for the first time in Hong Kong in addition to the regular ISL&T in San Francisco in 2008.

The ISL&T-Hong Kong 2008, with the theme “Chronic Tendinopathy & Bone-Tendon Junction Repair,” will be held on April 10, 2008, in conjunction with several international meetings including the **5th World Congress of Sports Trauma (WCST)**, the **6th Asian-Pacific Orthopaedics Society for Sports Medicine (APOSSM) Meeting** and the **6th Academic Congress of Asian Shoulder Association (ACASA)**.

This symposium features more in-depth discussion on the above two topics and aims to compile current concepts in these areas to inspire further research direction while maintaining the ISL&T integrative meetings tradition. The symposium will be comprised of panel discussion and free paper presentations. We expect that this symposium will attract leading researchers as well as clinical experts who are attending the concurrent meetings.
